- Completed Assessment roadmap, interview/survey questions, and survey results
- Next steps interviews with SC/SAC; Workshop in April/May to discuss results, affirm commitment, and explore actions; Final assessment



What's been going on....

- NBEP Green Infrastructure Planning RFP
 - Awarded \$649,000 to 11 projects; 2 capacity building to develop projects and 9 project planning (from 10% design through 70% design and permitting)
- Blackstone Initiative
 - Blackstone Needs Assessment—Done; Supported the hire of a Watershed Manager to create the Blackstone Collaborative.
 - Blackstone Fish Passage—progress towards fish passage through/across the 4 lower dams on the Blackstone
- Bi-partisan Infrastructure money
 - NBEP set to receive ~\$900,000 and plans to re-grant all the money

 - Social Science finalized 2-pp summary documents on chosen indicators to be explored next year (next meeting April 25)
 - Salt Marsh meeting to discuss new funding through infrastructure and figure out next steps
